HOSPITAL MEDICAL SCRAP DISPOSAL

Sealed tenders are invited from experienced and financially sound contractors for the disposal of hospital medical scrap, viz.

- 1 Empty card boards
- 2 IV Fluid 500 ml glass bottles
- 3 IV Fluid 100 ml glass bottles
- 4 IV Fluid 500 ml plastic bottles
- 5 IV Fluid 100 ml plastic bottles
- 6 Injection vials
- 7 Other scrap, such as waste plastic bags, bottles, empty cotton boxes

Scrap items can be inspected on any working day from 10 a.m. to 3.30 p.m. after contacting the security officer.

On an average two canter loads of the above scrap is generated in the hospital every week.

The period of tender is one year.

Tender forms and terms and conditions may be obtained on payment of Rs.1000/- (non refundable) from the Accounts Office of the C.B.C.I. Society for Medical Education, St. John's Medical College Hospital from 19th June, 2010 till 29th June 2010 between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm. on all working days.

The completed Tender form shall be submitted in a sealed envelope to the Secretary, C.B.C.I. Society for Medical Education, St. John's Medical College Hospital, Sarjapur Road, Bangalore- 560 034 along with a DD for Rs. 5,000/- (Refundable) as EMD drawn in favour of Secretary, C.B.C.I. Society for Medical Education, payable at Bangalore on or before 4.00 pm on 30-6-2010.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE DISPOSAL
OF MEDICAL SCRAP**

- 1 The contract of clearing the scrap materials is for a period of one year.
- 2 The successful bidder is required to deposit the bid amount in advance towards the value of the scrap by DD/bankers cheque drawn in favour of the Secretary, C.B.C.I. Society for Medical Education, St. John's Medical College Hospital, Bangalore and produce the receipt to the Personnel Department before clearing the first lot.
- 3 In addition, the successful bidder shall deposit an interest free refundable security deposit amounting to **Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One lakh only)** (hereinafter called the "**Security Deposit**"), in favour of the Secretary, C.B.C.I. Society for Medical Education, St. John's Medical College Hospital, Bangalore which shall be refunded and returned to the successful bidder in the event of termination or expiration of the agreement.
- 4 The materials have to be cleared on daily basis under the supervision of the members of the Disposal committee and security.
- 5 The site and the surrounding areas have to be cleaned immediately each time after clearing the materials. If the

successful bidder fails to keep the area clean, the management of St. John's Medical College Hospital will take up the cleaning work and deduct the amount from the security deposit.

- 6 Entry pass for the workmen and vehicles will be issued by the Security Officer.
- 7 The successful bidder should inform the Stores Superintendent before loading the scrap items.
- 8 The successful bidder will shift the items from the hospital premises only with the gate pass issued by the Stores Superintendent.
- 9 In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder to clear the items at the stipulated time, the Management of St. John's Medical College Hospital reserves the right to terminate the contract and no claim would be entertained thereafter.
- 10 The successful bidder cannot sub-licence or sub-contract the scrap disposal contract to any other person or agency.
- 11 The successful bidder or his representative is not permitted to remove any other material from the hospital scrap yard.
- 12 The successful bidder should not engage any minors for the work at the scrap disposal yard.
