

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. MHA ADMISSIONS

a. Date and Time

Admissions of selected candidates to MHA course will be held from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM on the following date in St. John's Medical College, Sarjapura Road, Bangalore 560 034.

b. Eligibility Certificate (to be procured before the Admission Process)

Selected Candidates with Bachelors' degree from Universities other than **Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS) Karnataka**, apply online (www.rguhs.ac.in) for the **Eligibility Certificate**. A copy of the same will be produced at the Academic Section on the day of admission for verification by the Dean.

c. Admission Procedure

Step 1 - Admissions Office

Selected candidates report to the ADMISSIONS Office situated in the ground floor of St. John's Medical College, submit the acceptance letter and obtain an ADMIT SLIP.

Step 2 - Academic Section

With the ADMIT SLIP, Candidates report to the ACADEMIC SECTION (diagonally opposite to Admissions Office), submit original documents, and obtain a written clearance for admission from the Superintendent of the Academic Section. A copy of the eligibility certificate, applied online will also be submitted.

Step 3 - Approval from Director and Dean

With the written clearance from the Academic Section, candidates meet the Director and the Dean in their respective offices for approval of admission. **Note:** Admissions are **"PROVISIONAL"** until all the original supporting documents submitted are accepted and approved by the RGUHS, Karnataka.



Step 4 - Hostel Accommodation

Those who wish to have Hostel Accommodation on Campus meet the Associate Director of College in his office to obtain permission for Hostel Accommodation. **Note:** Hostel rooms must be occupied by 5:00 pm on Monday, 28 August 2017, the latest.

Step 5 - Placing Order for Uniform

Candidates place order and pay for the uniform in MHA office, 4th floor, St. John's Medical College, on the day of the admission. The cost of the uniform is Rs.5600/-.

Step 6 - Payment of Fees

Admitted candidates pay the fees in the Accounts Office. The first semester fees must be paid in full to complete the admission process. The first semester fee for MHA Course is:
