1. Candidates are required to report by 8.00 am.at the Entrance to the Golden Jubilee Block of St. John's Medical College
2. The Examination is of 1 hour 30mins duration, MCQ type on OMR answer sheets.
3. Candidates are required to bring:
 - a. Official Photo ID (Aadhar(updated)/Passport/Electoral card/Pan card/ Driving licence). **Candidates without photo ID will NOT be permitted to enter the Examination Hall.**
 - b. Blue or black ballpoint pen. GEL PEN is not allowed
 - c. Printed Hall Ticket (To print the Hall Ticket, login to the admission portal with User name/email ID and password, download and print the Hall Ticket). Candidates who are unable to generate the Hall Ticket must bring a printed hard copy of the application form and report to the Examination Centre at 8.00 am.
4. Candidates are NOT ALLOWED to bring any of the following inside the Examination Hall.
 - Papers other than the Admit Card/Hall Ticket.
 - Electronic gadgets like mobile phones, pagers, smart watches, calculators etc
 - Candidates found with any of the above items on their person during the examination will be disqualified.
5. Each candidate will be given an Envelope containing the Question paper and OMR Answer Sheet
 - Instructions regarding answering the test are given on the envelope. Please read the instructions carefully before answering.
 - Take care to enter your **Application Number correctly on OMR Answer Sheet**. Please refer section B of this document for the instructions on appropriate shading of the answers. Incorrect entry of Application Number will disqualify you.
 - Refer to the Envelope for the instructions on appropriate shading of the answers.
 - Please use **blue/black ball point pen** to mark answers clearly on the OMR Answer Sheet. **Do not use gel pen/ink pen.**
 - There is **no negative marking** in this exam.
6. After completing the exam, the Question Paper and Answer sheet have to be handed over to the Invigilator before leaving the hall.
7. **Interview:** Interview for the MPT & M.Sc MLT candidates will be held on 11th July 2023, starting at 11.00 am. The interview batch list details and time is put upon the notice board. Candidates are required

to report to the help desk counter near the Dean Office, Ground floor, Medical College building, 15 mins prior to the Scheduled time.

8. **Result Announcement:** The list of candidates selected for admission will be published on the Institutional website www.stjohns.in on 12th July 2023. The Admission procedure for the selected candidates will start on 13th July 2023.

9. **Admission:**

Selected candidates interested in taking admission will have to report to the Admission office, ground floor college building at 9.00am on 13th July 2023 onwards.
