Candidates who are unable to generate the Hall Ticket must bring a printed hard copy of the application form and report to the Examination Centre at 8.00 am.
- 4. Please note that **only candidates who have secured 45 % and above (40 % for SC/ST Karnataka candidates)** in the qualifying PUC/ Standard XII Examination are eligible for admission as per University regulations.
- 5. Candidates are NOT ALLOWED to bring any of the following inside the Examination Hall.
 - Papers other than the Admit Card/Hall Ticket.
 - Electronic gadgets like mobile phones, ear pods, pagers, smart watches & calculators etc
 - Candidates found with any of the above items on their person during the examination will be disqualified.
