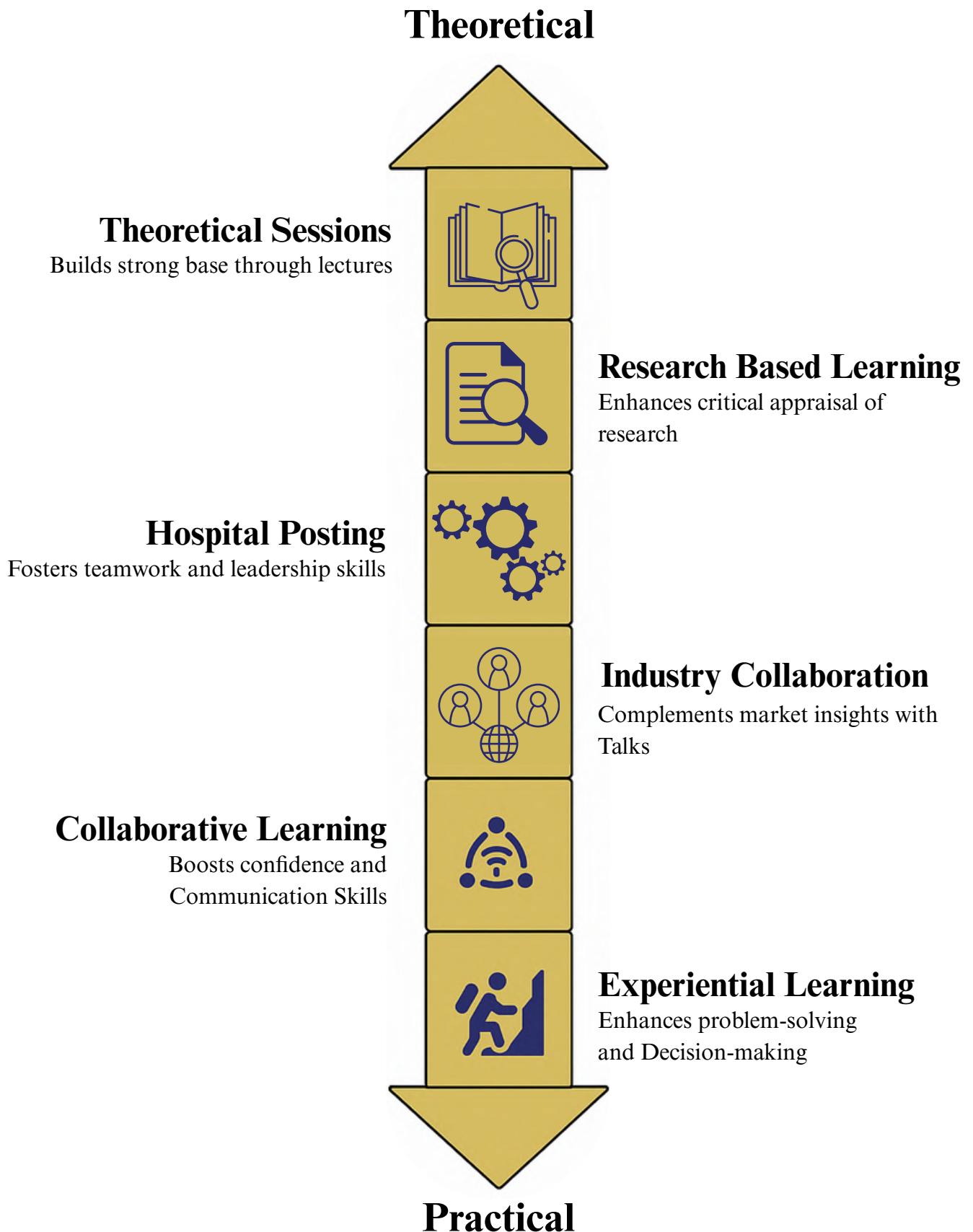
ABOUT THE MHA PROGRAM
