

Well Baby Services

Department of paediatrics and nursing provide comprehensive well baby services at paediatric outpatient department from Monday to Saturday between 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM.

Services include, growth plotting and monitoring, breast feeding counselling, nutritional advice, immunization and screening for developmental delay. Paediatric resident and a junior consultant will be manning the clinic, which will be supported by senior consultants. Vaccination will be administered by well-trained nursing personnel within the premises of paediatric OPD. Mothers and infants requiring additional help for breast feeding will be referred to lactation clinic which is handled by trained counsellors. Some services can be obtained between 4-6 pm in evenings as a part of special consultations.

OPD services – Room No 22 – Main OPD Block

OPD Services are led by Faculty from Unit 1, 2, 3

Average of 150- 200 children are seen daily in OPD

Paediatric outpatient service is provided at room number 22 of the outpatient block from Monday to Saturday between 9 am and 2 pm. All children aged between 1 month to 18 years will be taken care of by trained paediatricians. Services include comprehensive preventive as well as diagnostic modalities. Preventive services include, growth plotting and monitoring, breast feeding counselling, nutritional advice, immunization and screening for developmental delay. Infants requiring immunization are seen by priority in well baby clinic in the same premises. Team of consultants includes senior professors, associate and assistant professors with wide experience in common childhood diseases and handling complicated/rare diseases. After check- up, possible diagnosis, investigation and treatment plan and a follow up plan will be discussed with parents. Sick children requiring immediate care will be seen on a priority basis and shifted to emergency room for initiating treatment. Cross consultations from other specialties' will be taken if need arises
