Mega Vaccination Drive

On 17/9/21 a mega vaccination drive was organized by the Government of India. A total of 2.5 crore people were the beneficiaries in India & 30 lakh people were vaccinated in Karnataka.

A total of 58 Ist yr GNM and 55 - 4th yr BSC Nursing students were involved.
