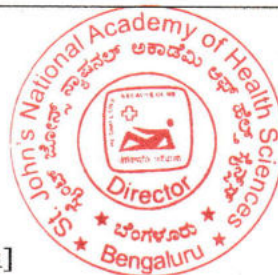

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Telephonic Seat Counselling**

- i. The candidates selected for Seat Counselling will receive an Option Entry Form by email by 13 September 2020.
- ii. Download the Option Entry Form, fill it up, scan it and email it back to admission2020@stjohns.in and dean.sjmc@stjohns.in.
- iii. **The Telephonic Seat Counselling will take place on 18 September 2020.** The timing of the Telephonic Counselling will be communicated by email to each of the provisionally selected Candidates.
- iv. In case the Option Entry Form duly filled is not received in the Admissions Office by 15 September 2020, the Candidate will forfeit the seat.
- v. After the Telephonic Seat Counselling, the candidates will receive an **Admit Slip** with the allotted course. Candidates are required to confirm the admission by paying the **fee online by Tuesday, 22nd September 2020.**
- vi. **Selected candidates who do not pay the fee within the specified time will have forfeited their seats.**
