1. Candidates who are provisionally selected are instructed to forward your acceptance letter via email to dean.sjmc@stjohns.in and admission2020@stjohns.in at the earliest.
2. In order to confirm the seat, FEES are to be paid online by **04:00 pm** on or before **Thursday, 17 September 2020 (Fee details and Mode of Payment are given below)**. Any candidate who fails to pay the fees by **4:00 pm** on **17 September 2020**, will forfeit the seat and this seat will be allotted to the candidate on the waitlist.
3. In view of the Corona Pandemic, details of the Course Inauguration, Student Orientation, Course Commencement and Date of Reporting physically to the College will be intimated later.
