INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

- Detailed Instructions with screen capture images are available on the website under the link 'How to fill online application form'. Please refer to the images and instructions before registering and filling the Online Application Form.

Pre-requisites for filling the online application form:

- It is the responsibility of the candidate to read the prospectus and instructions provided on the Institutional website and to ensure completeness of the application forms. Incomplete forms will be rejected.
- A valid E-mail ID and Mobile Number is mandatory for the submission of the Online Application form. This E-Mail ID and Mobile number should be active till the declaration of results. The Admission section will send important information regarding your application on this registered E-Mail ID/Mobile number.
- **Please Note:** After the final online submission, the particulars mentioned in the online application form will be considered as Final. NO further modifications will be allowed & NO correspondence regarding change of details will be entertained. Candidates are hence requested to fill in the online application form with utmost care.

Registration process to be done prior to filling the application form:

- For registration, candidates are first required to click the Online Application Link under the Nursing tab on the Institution Admission Website www.stjohns.in or use the link <http://admissions.stjohns.in>. The registration forms will popup.
- Fill up the registration form with the required information.
- Once you submit the above information, USER ID (registered email) and PASSWORD will be sent by email to the registered Email ID & a SMS with the same information will be sent to your registered mobile number.
- After receiving your User ID and Password, you will NOT be able to edit your Name, Email and Mobile Number. In case you need to change these fields after submitting the primary registration form saving, then you will have to repeat the registration process to obtain a new User ID and Password.

Steps for submitting the online application form

- Go to the Link and click on the Online Application Form Link under the Nursing tab.
- Enter you registered User ID and password.
- Fill the online application form appropriately with accurate information
- Before submitting, check the details for completeness and accuracy.
- Upload a passport size colour photograph of the candidate.
Specification for photograph: Recent colour passport-size photograph (taken after November 2019), in JPEG/JPG format not exceeding 340 kb.
- Make the ONLINE PAYMENT using any one of the methods provided- credit card / debit card or Net Banking. NO OTHER PAYMENT MODE WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Once the transaction has been completed, a printable receipt of your payment will also be generated for your reference.

- After completion of the whole process, a printable copy of your application form with all the filled-in details will be available. Check the details and submit your form. You will receive an Application number. Retain the number for your reference and any further communication.
- After the final submission, the Admission office will check and approve the application form. This will take approximately 48-72 hours.
- After approval the candidate will receive an SMS/Email confirmation.

2. This entire application form is meant to be submitted online. If you get interrupted after you submit the basic Information or while uploading your photograph, you can sign in again using your User ID and password and refill the form.

COURSE DETAILS AND ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLICATION

01. Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course:

A. Eligibility Criteria

- a. The College admits only female candidates
- b. The candidates should have completed 17 years of age on or before 31st December, 2020
- c. Minimum Educational qualification is pass in the Pre-University Examination of Karnataka Board of Pre-University Education with an aggregate of 45% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects (40% for SC&ST Candidates) Or any other examination recognized by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences as equivalent to 2 years PUC. English as a subject in PUC is mandatory.
EQUIVALENCY IS DETERMINED ONLY BY THE RAJIV GANDHI UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, BANGALORE.
- d. Students' awaiting results may also apply.
- e. Religious Sisters should have completed one year after their religious profession & should not be beyond 35 years of age.

C. Selection:

Candidates who meet the above requirements are required to appear for an entrance test of one hour in Physics, Chemistry & Biology of the Pre-University Level.

The entrance Test & Interview will be conducted at College of Nursing, Bangalore.

Students awaiting PU result may also appear for the Entrance & Interview, but admission will be confirmed only after declaration of their result subject to the candidate securing requisite marks.

02. Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course:

A. Eligibility Criteria

- a. The College admits only female candidates
- b. Passed Pre-University Examination of Karnataka or its equivalent which is recognized by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences:
- c. Possess certificates of General Nursing and Midwifery from a recognized School of Nursing.
- d. Be a Registered Nurse under the State Nursing Council
- e. Be a member of TNAI
- f. Not above 46 years of age.

C. Selection

Applicants who fulfill the admission requirement will be called for a personnel interview at the College of Nursing.

Mess fee is Rs. 2,000/- per month.

03. General Nursing & Midwifery Course:

A. Eligibility Criteria

- a. The College admits only female candidates
- b. Minimum & Maximum age for admission will be 17 and 35 years. There is no age bar for ANM/LHV.
- c. 10+2 class passed preferably sciences (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks.
- d. 10+2 vocational ANM under CBSE Board or other equivalent board from the school and recognized by Indian Nursing Council with 40% marks.
- e. Religious sisters, who apply should have completed one year after their first religious profession.
- f. Students awaiting result also may apply,

B. How to Apply

Download the application form from our website www.stjohns.in fill the application form and attach the following documents along with the application.

- a. Xerox copies of the qualifying exam and certificate showing Date of Birth.
- b. If SC/ST, certificate issued by the Tahsildar
- c. A Demand draft for Rs. 250/- (Application form fees) drawn in favour of St. John's College of Nursing and made payable in Bangalore. This amount is not refundable.

It is the responsibility of the candidate to complete the application and the enclosures correctly. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

C. Selection

Applicants who fulfill the admission requirement will have an interview. Admission is subject to performance in Interview followed by document verification.

04. M.Sc. Nursing course**A. Eligibility Criteria**

- a. The College admits only female candidates
- b. Minimum Educational qualification is B.Sc. Nursing Degree of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka OR any of the other University considered to an equivalent by the RGUHS.
- c. One-year Experience (after B.Sc. (N) Result) in any clinical/teaching areas, either in a hospital or in a community.
- d. Minimum one-year experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- e. B.Sc. (N) course Registration with the State Nursing Council
- f. 55% marks in first attempt at B.Sc. /PBBS Nursing Examination. For SC/ST of Karnataka State only 50%.

05. M.Sc (N) in Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care Nursing (NPCC)

A. Eligibility Criteria

- a. The college admits only women candidates.
- b. Applicants must possess a registered B.Sc. Nurse with a minimum of one-year clinical experience in any critical care setting prior to enrolment.
- c. Must have undergone B.Sc. Nursing in an institution recognized by INC.
- d. Must have scored not less than 55% aggregate marks in the B.Sc. programme.
- e. Should be a registered nurse in state nursing council
